Our beach house is equipped with hot showers and rest-rooms. The beach sand and shoreline are cleaned and maintained.



**Pram Sailing lessons.** For youths 8 years of age and older, that have passed beginner level swimming, this is your chance to learn to sail. Prams are flat bottomed two-person sailboats. Each summer 10 prams hit the water off the Gladstone Marina. Participants receive hands-on instruction and once skills have been mastered free



sailing times are offered on week-day afternoons. Lessons begin July 19.

# Activities at the Rec Center

The Rec Center offers a variety of programs and activities for youth ranging from preschool through high school. Along with an open game room and available recreation equipment, the center offers:

### **T-Ball for ages 2-4**
